

## ***ATTENTION: MUSTARD GROWERS!!***

Based on the contracts being issued, RMA answers some potential questions.

Q1. When contract states acres and lbs./acre, **are optional units available?**

A1. Acreage insured to fulfill a processor contract, which provides that the processor will accept a designated amount of production or a combination of acreage and production **will not** be eligible for optional units.

Q2. What if the insured **plants more acres** than are stated in the contract?

A2. The acreage reported as insurable will be the acreage stated in the processor contract. The remaining acreage **must** be reported uninsurable. Also production to count for indemnity whether harvested or appraised is from all planted acreage (**insurable and uninsurable**) within each unit and will be divided by the number of planted acres to establish average yield. This yield will be multiplied by the insured acreage to determine production for claim and subsequently for APH. This eliminates the which acres were insured and which were not.

Q3. If a producer has **multiple contracts**, how does the insurance company know which acreage is covered by which contract?

A3. The producer **must** designate on the acreage report, what acreage is under which contract. When a contract specifies a production amount, each contract represents a different basic unit.
